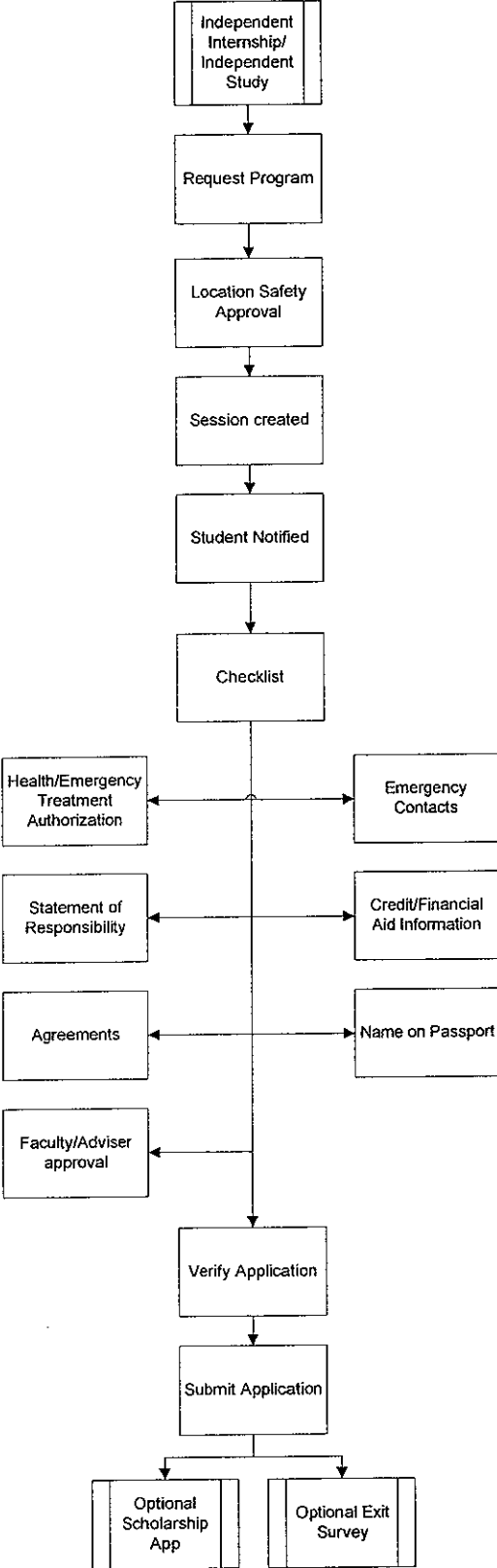

Awards Based on Financial Need and Academic Merit

If you have an overall GPA of 2.5 or better and a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file with the MSU Office of Financial Aid* you may be eligible for one or more of the following:

Awards Based On Academic Merit Only

If you have an overall GPA of 3.5 or better, you may be eligible for the following merit-only scholarships. Merit-only awards are among OSA's most competitive; most awardees have a GPA of 3.7 or above. However, a high GPA does not guarantee an award. The quality of the required essay is crucial. Your application for merit-only awards must include a 600-word essay describing how study abroad will help you reach your academic and personal goals. Your essay will be scored on both its content and the quality of writing. (Important: Do not exceed the 600-word limit.) No FAFSA is needed for these awards.

Scholarship Eligibility

MSU undergraduate students applying to any credit-bearing study abroad program are eligible for MSU Office of Study Abroad (OSA) Scholarships.

MSU graduate students applying to join a credit-bearing group program abroad are also eligible; however, graduate students pursuing individual or independent research abroad are not. A special award is reserved for MSU medical students doing independent study abroad.

Some scholarships are based exclusively on academic performance; others are based on a combination of academic performance and financial need. Some scholarships have additional requirements.

You need only submit one application in order to be considered for all the OSA scholarships for which you are eligible. You may receive more than one award.

All awards are very competitive! Only about 30% of applicants will receive an award.

To be considered, submit your scholarship application before the deadline corresponding to your program. You must submit a separate scholarship application for each program to which you apply.

If you withdraw from a program, for any reason (voluntary or involuntary), any award you may have won will be revoked. If your award is revoked after funds have been disbursed to you, you will be billed for the award amount through your MSU student account.


